



## Preschool Grant Programs

### What are the Grant Programs?

There are three grant programs within Farmington Public Schools

#### HEAD START

**GSRP** (Great Start Readiness Program)

**APEX** (Achieving Preschool Excellence)

**These are FREE programs IF you meet the requirements.**

### How do I qualify for these programs?

#### Head Start

- must be a resident of Farmington/Farmington Hills
- must be 3 or 4 by December 1st of current school year
- Income must be within the Federal Guidelines as documented with a current income tax return.

#### GSRP

- must be a resident of Farmington Public Schools
- must be four-years-old by December 1st of current school year
- must have at least two "At-Risk" factors documented

Some examples are:

- Low Family Income
- Single Parent
- Low Birth Weight (under 5lbs 8 oz)
- Teenage Parent
- Unemployed Parents
- Non-English or Limited English Speaking household
- Long-Term Chronic Illness
- Family of Low School Achievement or Dropout
- Lack of Stable Support System or Residence

#### APEX

- must be a resident of Oakland County
- must be four-years-old by December 1st of current school year
- must document two of the same at-risk factors as GSRP
