Description

English 9 is required of all ninth graders. This course, which includes a media center orientation, is designed to help students develop skills in all five language arts areas: reading, writing, speaking, listening and viewing. The primary focus will be on reading and interpreting young adult and classic literature, writing about those interpretations in various analytical and creative assignments, and presenting projects related to the readings in order to enhance oral skills.

EDP Course Planner

- Complete the entire column, by selecting 15 courses + alternates. **Carefully review selections at home with a parent or guardian and submit selections when your high school high school counselor comes to your middle school.**
 - If you have a **blue dot** on a course, read the warning to understand what is required in order to select this course.
 - If you have a **red dot** on a selected course, read the alert. You will not be able to submit your selections with any red dots

Course Planner continued

- **You are required to submit the course requests when your high school counselor visits your middle school**
- You won't be allowed to hit the **SUBMIT** button to lock your course selections until your counselor checks your course selections.
- Print out a Course Request Authorization Sheet
- Student and Parent/Guardian signatures are required on the last page
- Return signed Authorization Sheet to the Counseling Office in your Middle School.

English Options

- **English 9**

- This is the English class that the majority of our ninth graders take

- **Honors English 9**

- This curriculum is more challenging in the areas of reading, writing, and discussion. The 8th grade English teacher should be consulted to see if the student is a good candidate for this class. Check your high school's website to see if there is required reading for this class.

Science Options

- **Biology** is a required course for high school graduation
 - The majority of our students take Biology in 9th grade
- **Honors Biology** is also available
 - Ask your science teacher if this would be a good fit for you
- **Earth Science Essentials** is a required course for high school graduation
 - This course should be taken in 9th or 10th grade
- **Physics Essentials** meets the high school requirement for Physics
 - Students who plan to take advanced classes in Physics later in High School DO NOT need the Essentials course
 - Physics Essentials can only be taken in 9th-11th grade

Math Options

- Your high school counselor will be entering your math placement based on the math placement letter you received
- If you and your parent do not agree with the results, contact your middle school counselor for a recommendation override form

Social Studies and Physical Education

- You entered the following courses into your Course Planner already:
 - Civics
 - Economics
 - Intro to PE
 - Health
- Students who are taking music AND foreign language will need to have the high school counselor remove one of these four courses on their visit

World Language Requirement

- Beginning with the class of 2016, all students must complete two credits of the same World Language.
- Students who wish to take **Level 1** of a language in 9th grade should have at least a “C” in their regular Language Arts class. The choices are:
 - French I Japanese I Arabic I
 - Spanish I German I
- Students who wish to continue with **Level 2** of the language they took in 8th grade should have “A” or “B” grades all three terms
