**FPS Student/Parent Connect:** All students and parents should sign up for this program to keep updated on educational progress in each course. Information available includes attendance, schedule, food service data, emergency and immunization information, discipline and student grades. Only one login ID and password is needed for all the children in a household. (To obtain login information and password, contact the Counseling Center at (248) 489-3447. **FPS Listserve:** To stay current on all schools and their events, it is strongly recommended that parents/guardians sign up for Listserve. Use the following link, <http://www.farmington.k12.mi.us/subscribe.php> to subscribe for Farmington High School and any other listserves you may wish to receive. The FHS Counseling Department posts listserves approximately once a week.

**Educational Development Plan (EDP):** Every student updates their electronic database at least once a year with counselors and the Career Technicians, Mrs. Legacki and Mrs. Morgan. Students have an individual username and password and are able to update personal information at any time. Information in the EDP includes education and career plans, job experiences, community service, awards/honors, schedule, and course planner (online course selection).
