

Community invited to Empty Bowls Dinner at Kenbrook - Thursday, February 16

Farmington, Michigan—Kenbrook Elementary School is helping to combat hunger in the community by participating in the 20th Anniversary of Empty Bowls Supper on Thursday, February 16, 2012 from 6 - 8 p.m. Kenbrook is located at 32130 Bonnet Hill in Farmington Hills.

Empty Bowls is an international grassroots effort to fight hunger. The project began in Michigan in the spring of 1991. Due to the tremendous success of the project and the work of literally thousands of participants, Empty Bowls projects now occur throughout the year, raising millions of dollars to fight hunger.

A donation of \$10 for adults and \$3 for children will provide guests with a simple soup and bread supper in an empty bowl of their choice. Empty bowls were made and donated by students, parents, staff and community members. The money raised will be donated to a local charity.
