

Farmington Public Schools opens 20 kindergarten slots for Oakland County students for 2011-2012

Farmington, Michigan—Farmington Public Schools will accept Section 105 Schools of Choice applications from Oakland County families through Friday, August 26 for 20 openings in Kindergarten for the 2011-2012 school year. The openings are at the following elementary schools: Forest, Hillside, Kenbrook and Longacre. Final placement will be determined based upon staffing allocations, space availability, and the number of kindergarten applications received.

Applications must be received to the Office of Student Support Services by 4 p.m. on Friday, August 26, 2011. Kindergarten students will be notified of placement no later than Thursday, September 1, 2011.

If the number of applications received exceeds the number of spaces specified for Section 105 students, the District will use a random draw system to select the applicants who will be considered for enrollment in identified Section 105 School of Choice slots. If necessary, the lottery will be held at 9 a.m. on Monday, August 29 at the Lewis Schulman Administrative Center, 32500 Shiawassee St., Farmington.
