

Farmington Public Schools Attendance Policy

ATTENDANCE

Other than exempt absences as detailed below, students who are absent between eight and eleven times from a class, will be required to achieve at least a C+ (77% or greater) on the final exam to have his/her grade calculated for the term. If the student does not attain a C+ grade on the exam, the student will not receive credit for the course. Upon a student's twelfth absence from a class, he or she will not receive credit in the course.

Absences not calculated in the absence limits are:

- Exempt absences (school activities, legally documented court subpoena, suspensions, religious holidays, and medically verified long-term or chronic illness).
- Absences due to a death in the immediate family.

The assistant principal shall make the determination of a student's credit. If a student wishes to appeal this decision, he or she should submit a written request to the building principal, no later than four weeks after the term in question. The building principal's decision will be final.
