

# **FHS Prom FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) 2024**

When do doors open at prom? 6:30 pm sharp

When do doors close? YOU CANNOT ENTER PROM AFTER 7:45PM UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE

Is there re-admittance? NO! Once you leave the building, you can NOT re-enter prom. Absolutely NO exceptions.

When is prom? Thursday, May 30th, 2024

Where is prom? Masonic Temple in Detroit (500 Temple St, Detroit, MI 48201)

When do we buy prom tickets and where? Prom tickets are on sale April 29th - May 3rd after school only in room 521

How much are tickets? \$50/person CASH ONLY!

What is included in our prom ticket?

Your dinner and a digital photo. You will provide your personal email and phone number when you purchase your ticket so you can view your digital photo after prom. You will be able to order photo packages through Focal Point IF YOU WANT after prom. Once the dance begins there will be a separate 360° photo booth with props that you can take pictures in.

Can we bring guests? Yes! Each student can bring one guest 20 years or younger. Please see below for rules.

How do we bring guests?

Stop by the main office to grab a guest pass (similar to Homecoming). Your guest must complete the guest form and return it to our main office for official approval. If your guest is a high school student, their school MUST approve them on that form. You MUST have had your guest pass approved by the FHS main office before purchasing your guests' tickets.

If your guest is an FHS student, do they need a guest pass form?

No! They also don't need to be present with you when you buy their ticket, BUT their obligations must also be checked before they can have a ticket purchased for them. You must also know their meal selection (chicken or veg).

What happens at prom?

Arrive at 6:30 and you'll be checked in (doors lock at 7:45pm). Once you check in you, will head into the ballroom for a professional photo (don't skip this step!) and a delicious plated dinner. After dinner, the dance party will begin with your DJ! Coat check will be available.

Is there a coat check at prom? Yes, once you enter you can check your coat, extra shoes, etc.

How do I pick my meal? You will select your meal when you purchase your ticket. This is also when you'll share any dietary restrictions. Choices will be a chicken florentine, a spinach and cheese ravioli (vegetarian), or a cornmeal eggplant (vegan). Salad and dessert will also be provided.

### How does seating work at dinner?

You will choose your table when you purchase your tickets so we recommend buying your tickets with your friends to guarantee you're at the same table. **This can NOT be changed once you select your table and there will be NO MOVEMENT of seats on the night of the event.** This is a formal event where all seating is determined in advance and will ensure that you get your correct meal that night. After the dinner you will be dismissed and all students can meet up with other friends for the remainder of prom.

### Where can we take Prom pictures?

FHS has the Warner Mansion reserved for prom pictures from 2:30pm - 5pm. It's a beautiful space and students always enjoy taking pictures at this venue. This is not a required event, no RSVP necessary, just come for pictures if you'd like!

**Are shoes required?** YES! Shoes must be worn the entire night. Bring a pair of flip flops if you're concerned about dancing in nice shoes.

### I'm remote this year, how do I buy my ticket?

For simplicity, we hope you can come after school one day and buy your ticket in person in room 521. ### How many sit at each table at dinner at prom? 10

**\*\*\*PLEASE NOTE:** This event is a seated dinner event and we ask that you please maintain proper etiquette. The event will be a lot of fun, and you will create memories that last a lifetime, but it is important that you remember to follow the rules. When dinner begins, please stay seated at your table unless a member of the Masonic Temple or school staff excuses you. Please do not move chairs, decorations, tableware, etc at any point during the event. Seats were chosen at ticket sales and it is imperative that we uphold these placements. Understand that there is an entire staff at our venue who are working their hardest to guarantee a great night for 350+ people... we need to make sure they can do their job effectively.
