## ABSENT VOTER BALLOT ENVELOPES - NEW FOR 2020

Absent voter ballot envelopes have a new look redesigned to meet USPS standards.

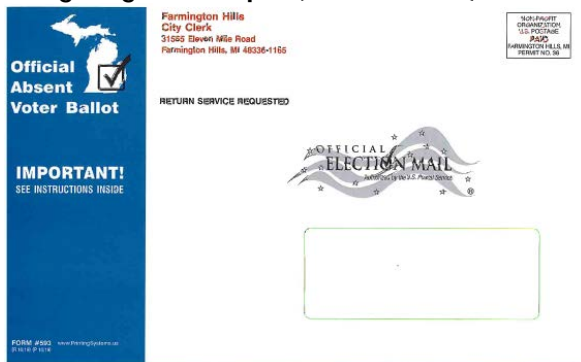
Voters requesting an absent voter ballot will receive a blue and white envelope containing their ballot starting with the March 10, 2020 Presidential Primary Election.

After voting the ballot, voters should place the ballot back inside the secrecy sleeve provided and then into the green and white return envelope to return the ballot to the City Clerk's Office.

**DON'T FORGET TO SIGN THE RETURN ENVELOPE** where indicated by the green arrow. A ballot cannot be accepted without the voter's signature.

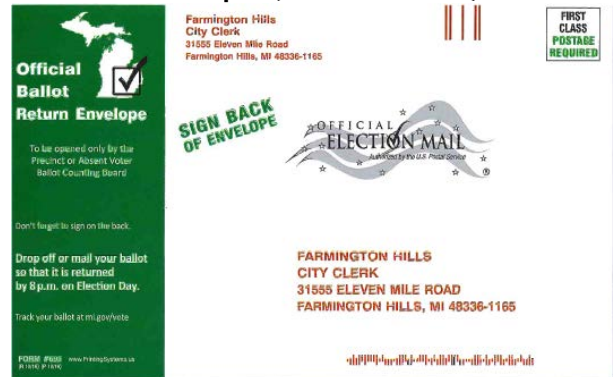

### Outgoing Envelope (Blue/White):

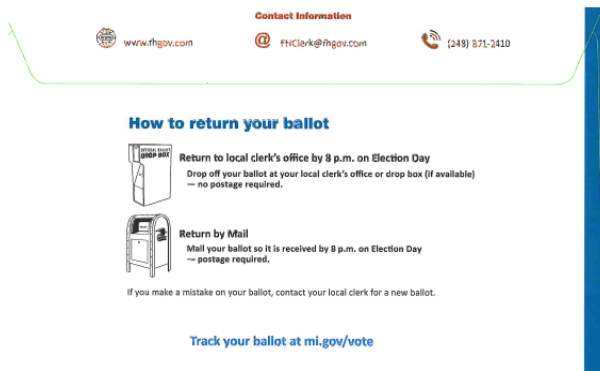

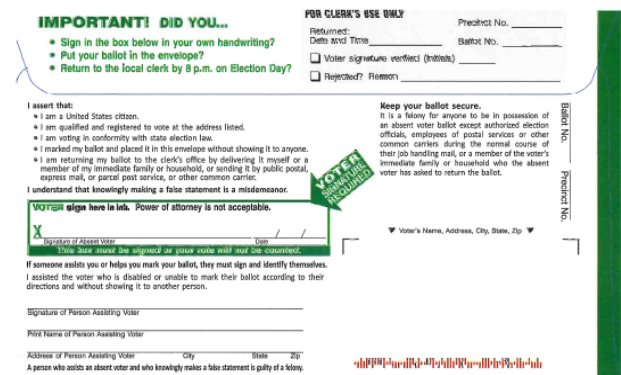
### Return Envelope (Green/White):
