I understand that FPS intends to maintain a similar course catalogue, but that not all courses currently offered are guaranteed to be offered in the future. Scheduling conflicts may arise which prevent a student from being enrolled in all courses desired and enrollment space in courses may not be available on a predictable, reliable pattern. The conditions have the potential of preventing a student from completion of an exchange.
