



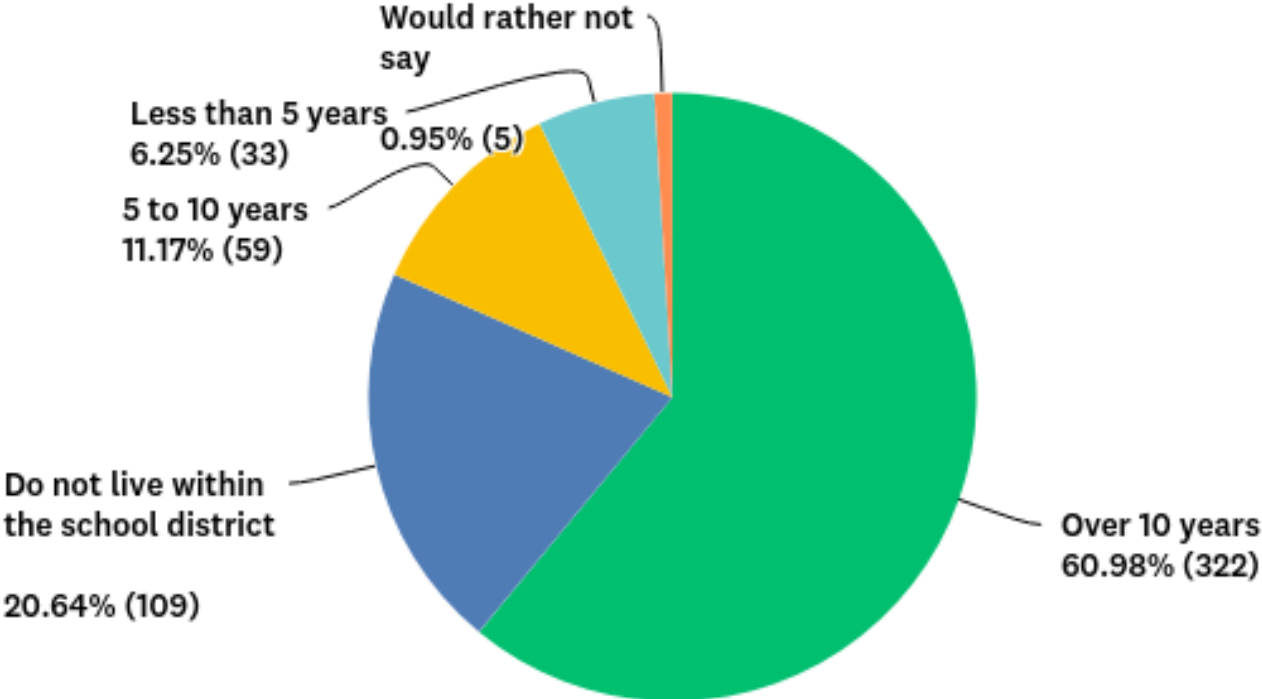

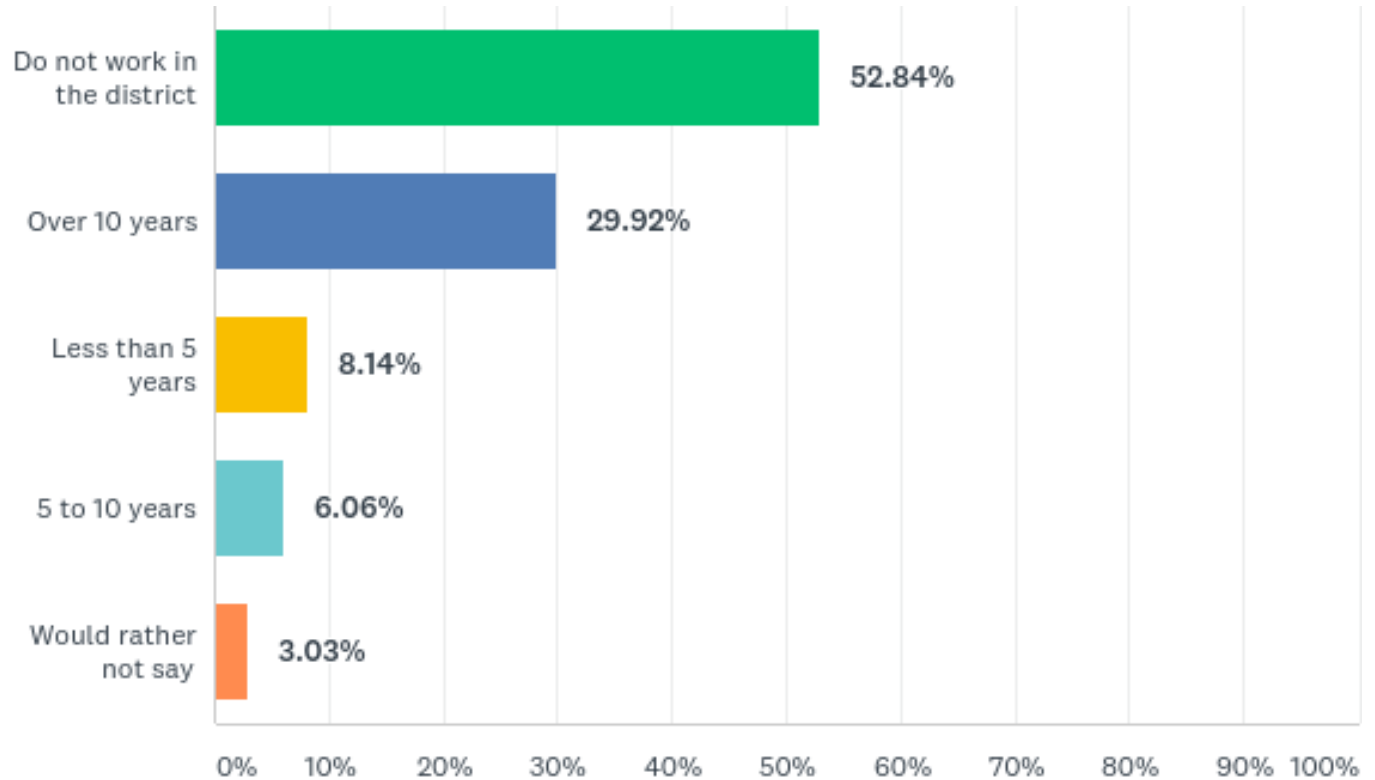
Q1: If you are a resident, how long have you lived in the school district?

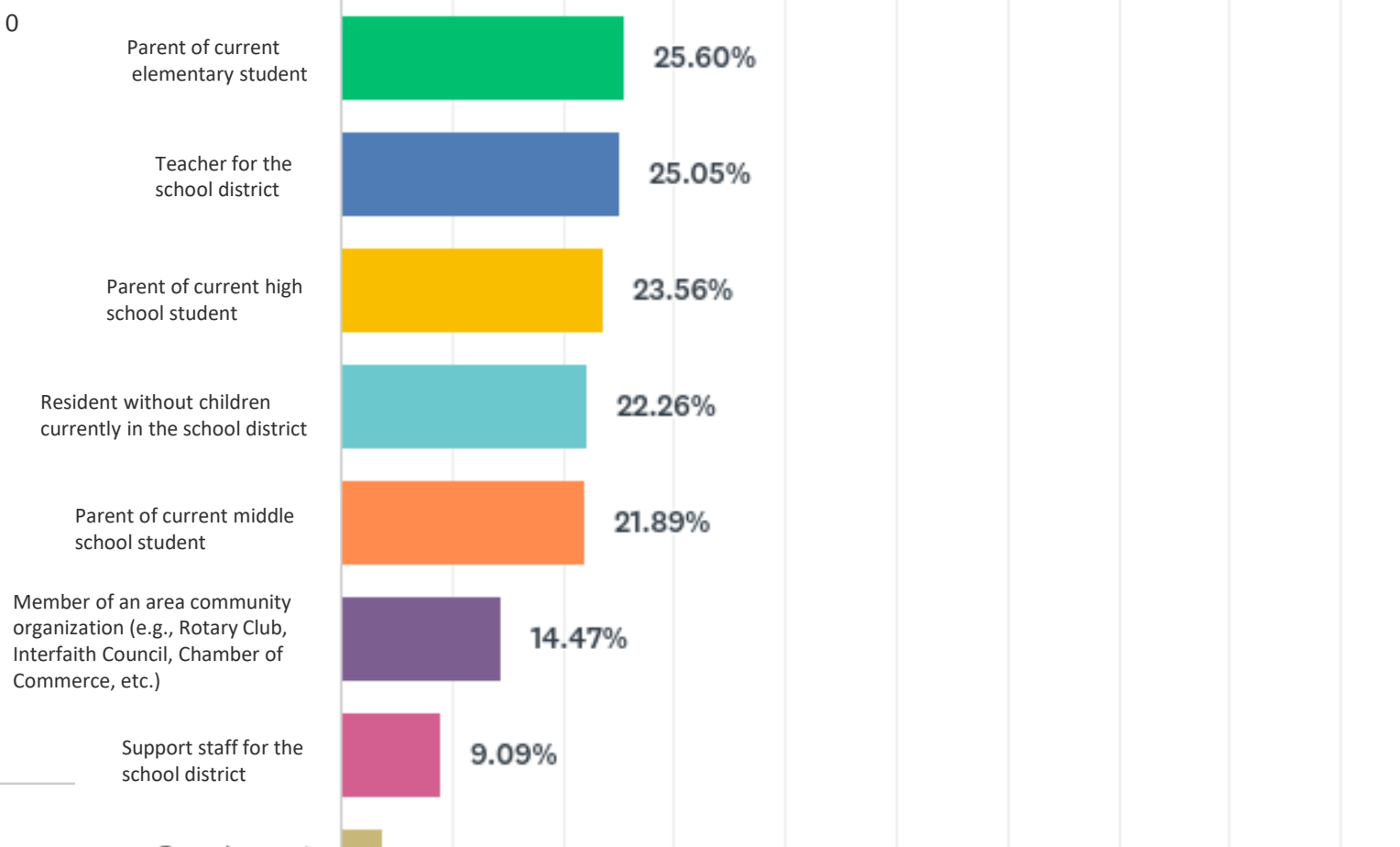
Q2: How long have you worked in the school district?

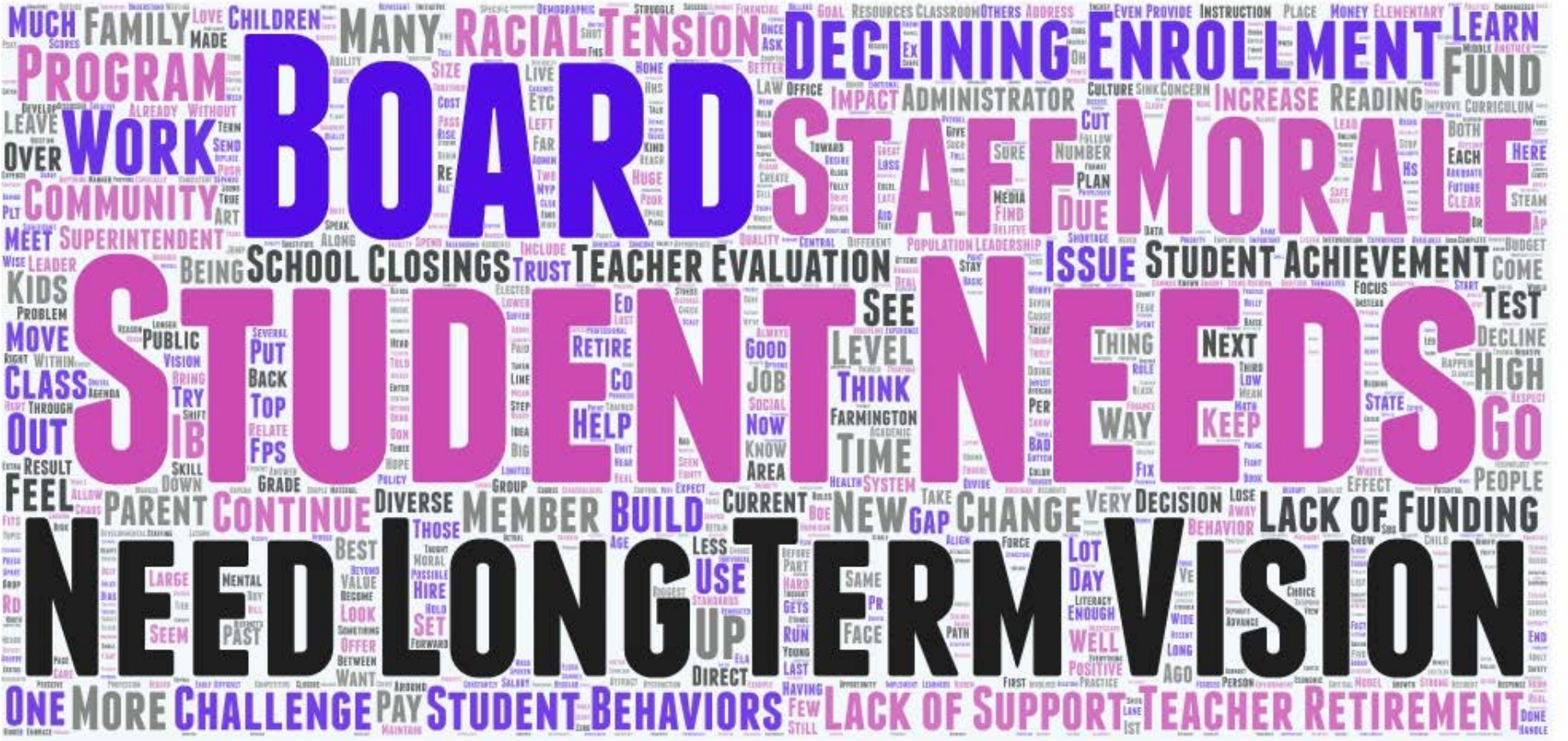

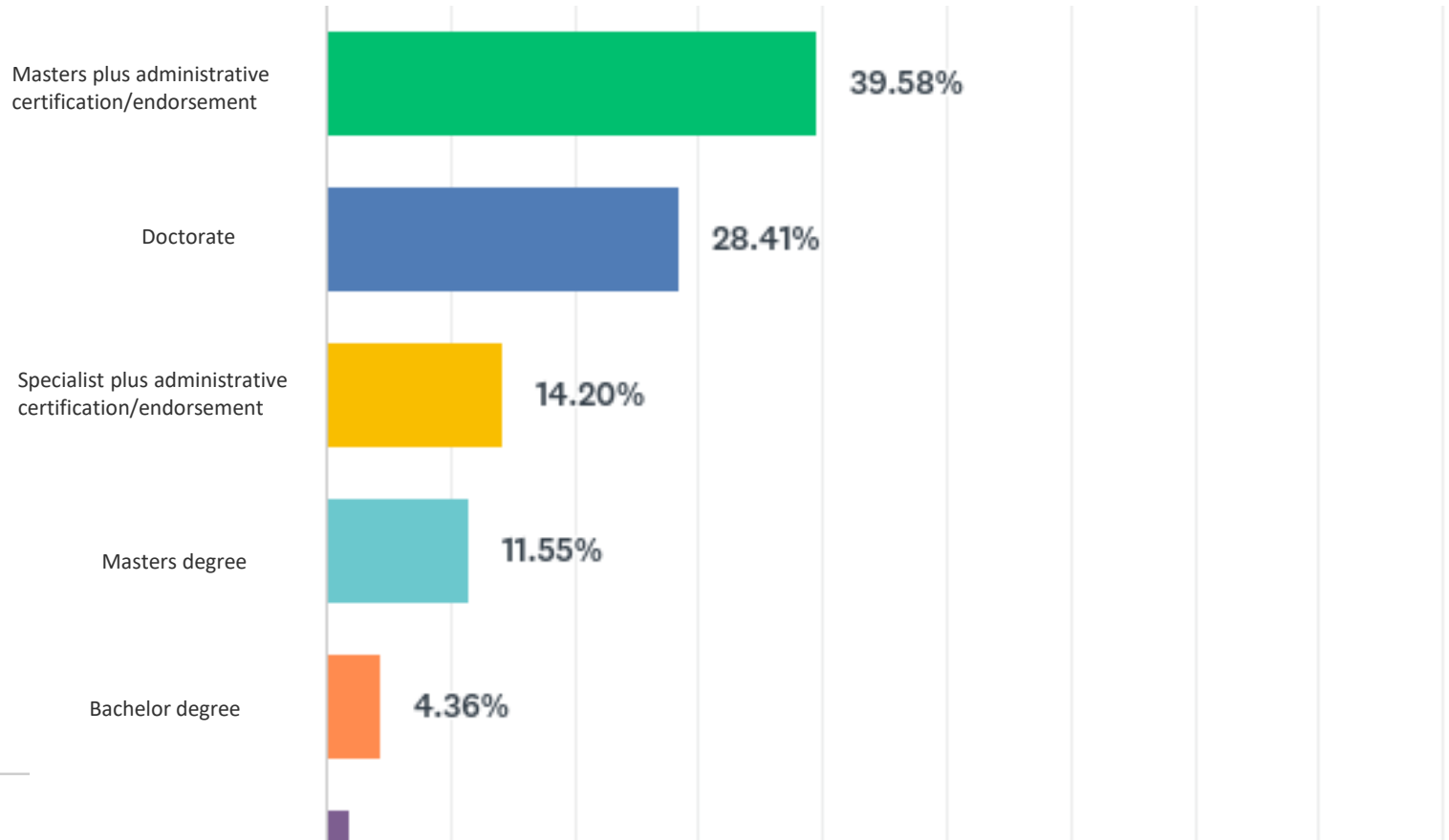


Q5: Challenges – STAFF PERSPECTIVE



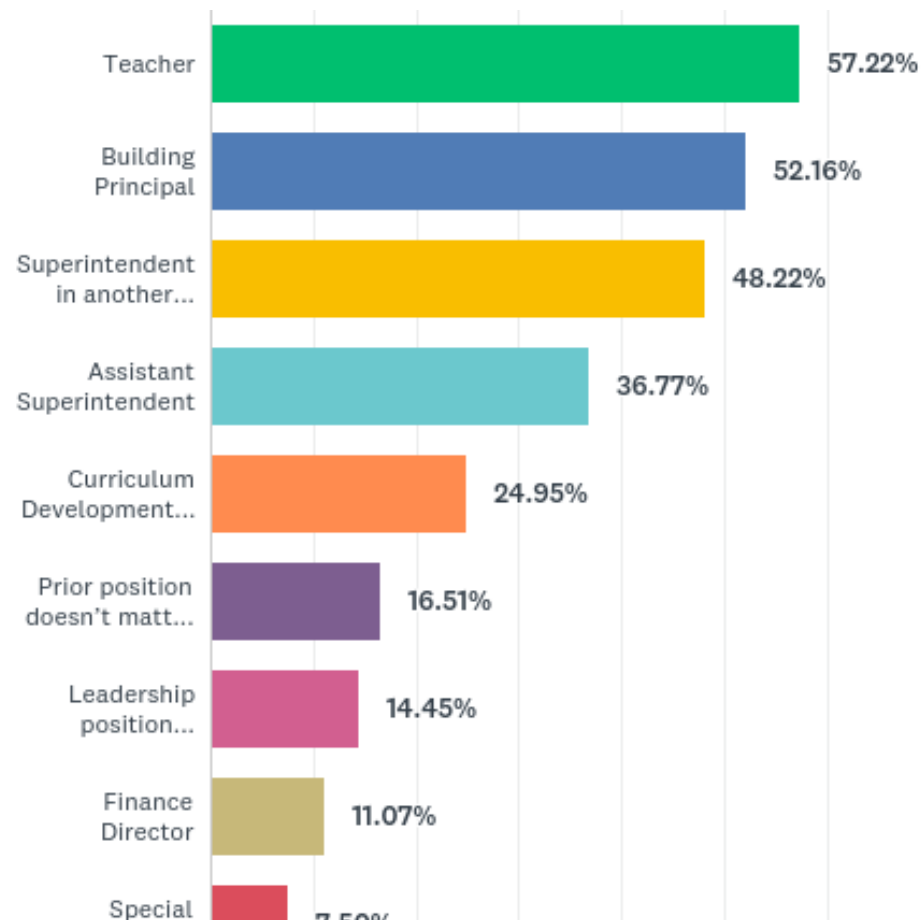

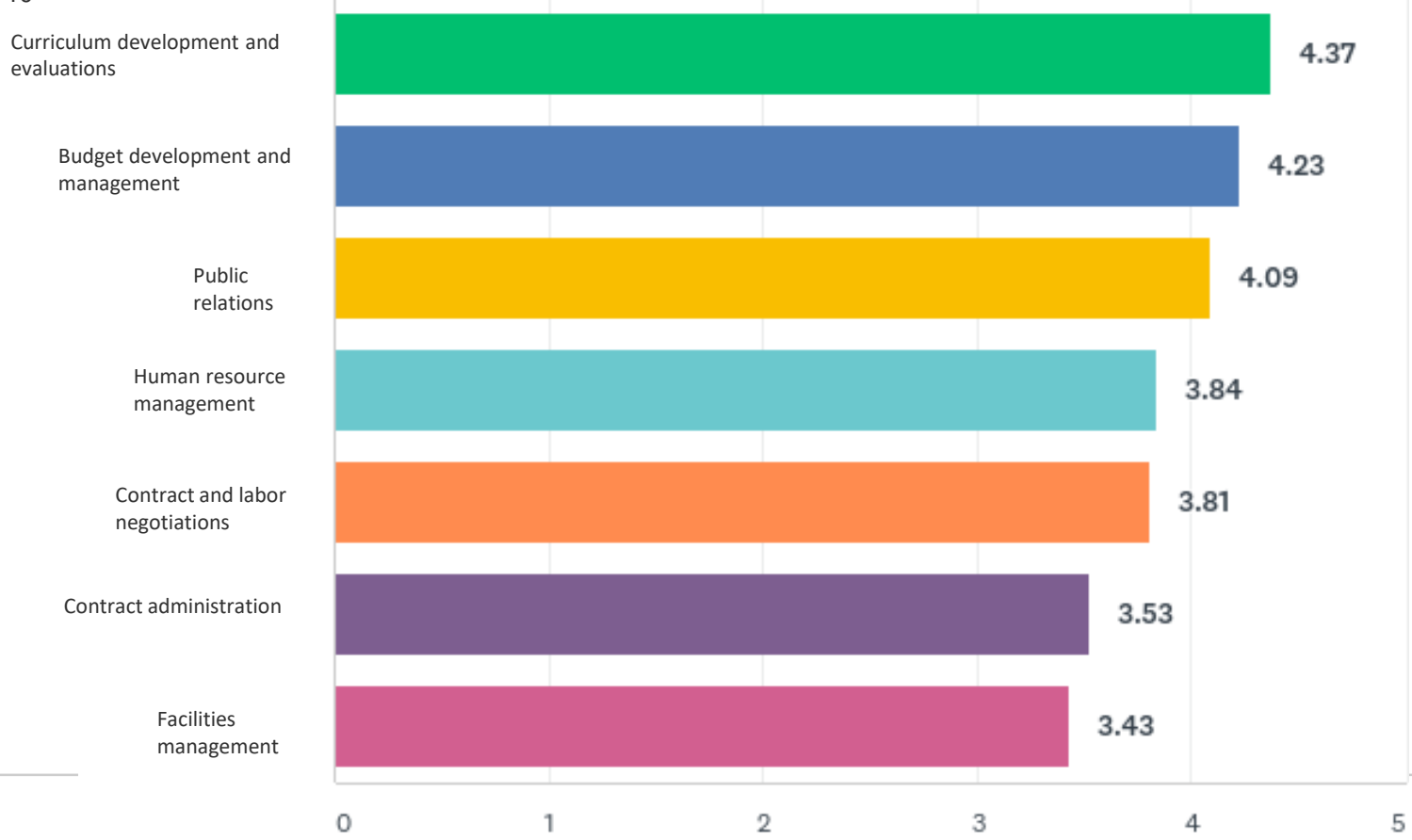

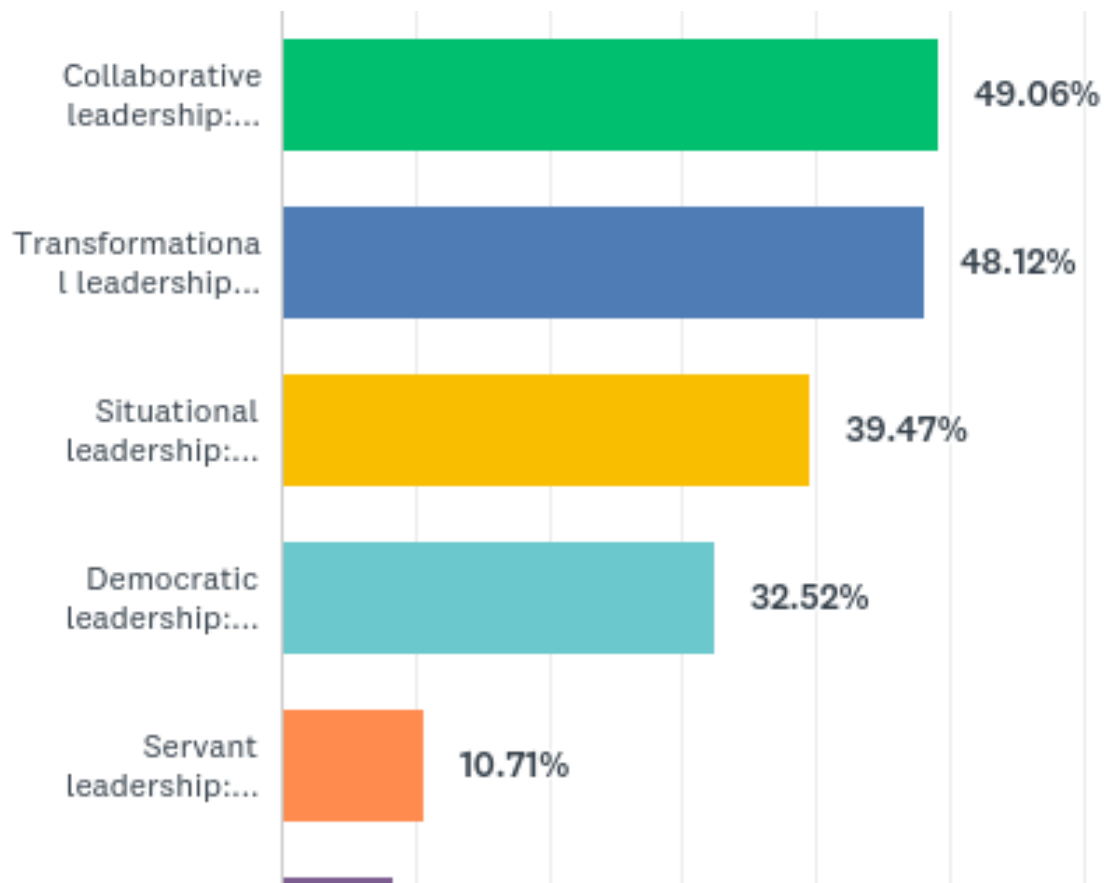
Q8: Areas of expertise

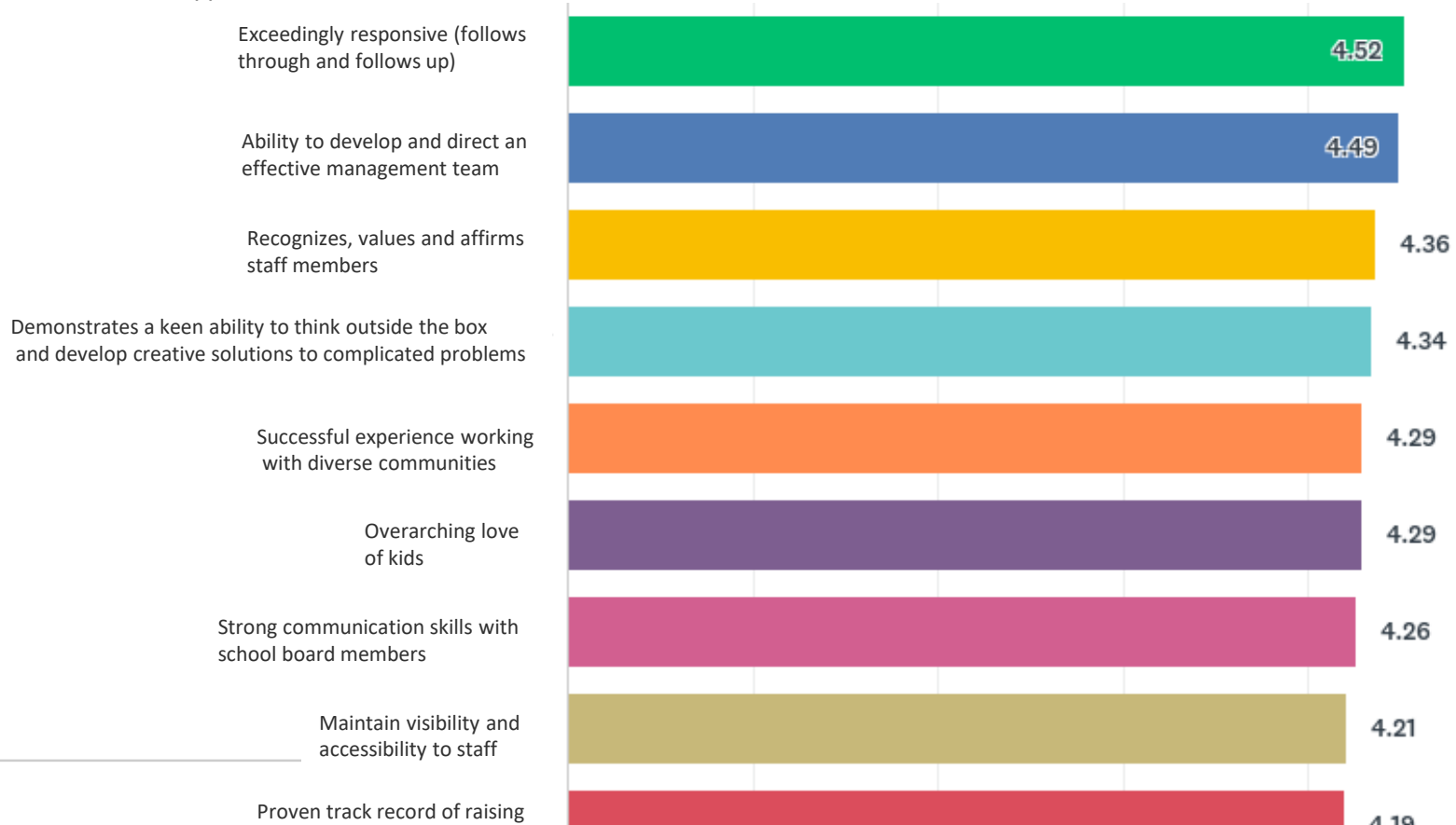

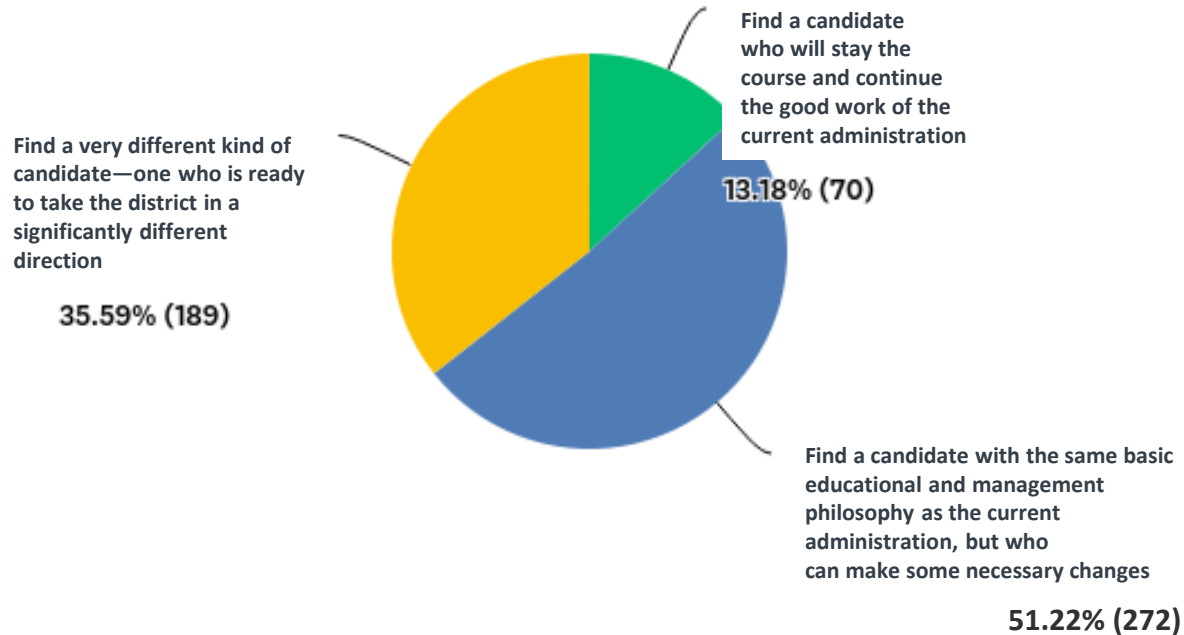
