




4th GRADE

SUPPLY LIST

Farmington Public Schools provides your child with all books, supplies, and materials necessary for the successful completion of fourth grade. Parents and students are always welcome to voluntarily provide additional supplies. Voluntarily providing supplies helps the school. If you wish to volunteer, we suggest providing the following items:

- \$5 (cash) for weekly science magazine
- Earbuds / headphones (will be sent home at the end of the year)
- Computer mouse ; USB with wire (will be sent home at the end of the year)
- Small backpack (no wheels)
- Gym shoes with light or non-marking soles (kept at school until the end of the year)
- Two wide-ruled composition books
- Four plastic folders with pockets (place child's name on the inside of each folder): yellow (reading), blue (desk), green (science), & red (social studies) 
- Eight black EXPO dry erase markers
- One zippered, three hole pencil pouch for binder (please place the following supplies inside your child's pencil pouch):
 - Large pink eraser
 - Child sized pointed scissors
 - Highlighter
 - Hand held pencil sharpener with enclosure to contain shavings
 - Pens (one red, one blue, and one green)
 - Two three-ring binders (1-inch wide) with clear overlay sheets so papers can be inserted into the outside cover
- One 8" X 5" supply box with the following items inside:
 - One pack of glue sticks
 - Colored pencils and/or crayons (12 or 24 count)
 - One pack of washable markers
 - Two boxes of 12 Ticonderoga No. 2 pencils (preferably sharpened)

The classroom donations below are needed and appreciated, but not required. Please do not label these items with your child's name:

- ★ Boxes of Kleenex tissue
- ★ Boxes of Crayola washable markers
- ★ Boxes of Crayons (24 or 48)
- ★ Boxes of Ticonderoga No. 2 pencils
- ★ Hand sanitizer
- ★ Boxes of pens (Blue, green, or red)
