

# First Grade School Supplies

Farmington Public Schools provide your child with all books, supplies and materials necessary for successful completion of first grade. Parents and students are always free to voluntarily provide school supplies. Voluntarily providing supplies helps the school. If you wish to provide supplies, we suggest some or all of these items with your child's name on each item:

- Gym shoes (to be left at school for the year)
- A regular-sized backpack with NO rollers or pull out handles (these will not fit in our lockers)
- Small, plastic supply box about 5 in. x 8 in. (This supply box will need to fit a box of crayons, markers, a pair of scissors, 1 or 2 glue sticks and 1 or 2 dry erase markers.)
- Spiral notebook (8  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 11)
- Child-sized pair of scissors
- Glue sticks (2 to 4)
- A small pair of headphones (to keep at school for the year)
- 1 green, **plastic** 2-pocket folder
- A hard-cover, **1 inch** binder with metal, snap-closing rings (This will be your child's Leadership Notebook that will come home at the end of the school year.)
- 2 to 4 **black**, dry erase markers (preferably skinny)
- Crayola 24 count box of crayons (there's not room for larger boxes)

## **note**

Your child's name needs to be on all above belongings.

- **One** of the following items to be shared with the class: large box of tissues, large pump bottle of hand sanitizer, package of baby wipes, **OR** gallon or sandwich sized zip baggies (no sliding zipper please).

Colored pencils don't work well in first grade; too much time is spent sharpening them. Markers can be used occasionally. If you send some, please make it a small pack of skinny markers, not the traditional fat ones.
