



SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

In Effect for the 2011/2012 School Year

Per the new Communicable Disease Rules passed by the Michigan Legislature in October 2009, the following school immunization requirements have changed or been added. These changes include all students newly enrolling in the District beginning January 1, 2010.

<u>Incoming students</u> must supply proof of these immunizations.

NEWRequired for all children entering kindergarten, all incoming sixth grade students, and all children changing school districts:

• Two doses of Varicella (Var) vaccine or history of chickenpox disease

NEWRequired for all children 11 through 18 years who are changing school districts or who are enrolled in 6^{th} grade:

- One dose of meningococcal vaccine (MCV4 or MPSV4)
- One dose of tetanus/diphtheria/acellular pertussis (Tdap) if 5 years have passed since the last dose of tetanus/diphtheria vaccine (DTaP, Td, DT)

Additional (previous)	school entry requirements: 4 years through 6 years	7 years through 18 years
Diptheria, Tetanus, Pertussis	4 doses DTP or DTaP, one dose must be on or after 4 yrs	4 doses D and T OR 3 doses Td if #1 given on or after 7 yrs of age.
Polio	4 doses (If dose 3 administered on or after 4 yrs, only 3 required)	3 doses
Measles*, Mumps*, Rubella*	2 doses on or after 12 months	2 doses on or after 12 mos.
Hepatitis B*	3 doses	3 doses
