(Positive, Learning, Understanding, & Support)

PLUS is a credit-based mentoring class that provides students with one-on-one academic and emotional support throughout their high school career. During PLUS, students have an opportunity to explore careers and colleges, set academic goals, participate in team-building activities, and complete SAT preparation.

Online Courses

FCHS offers classes within a traditional classroom and online courses. Students who are taking these courses have the ability to work on the curriculum with teachers in real-time. This allows students to work more efficiently and effectively with support.

6. Can students attend Oakland Schools Technical Center (OSTC)?

Yes. FCHS students are eligible for the programs that OSTC offers.
