NEW! In-person support will also be available at the North Farmington High School Summer Learning Lab, open Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m.–1 p.m. Students can drop in any time to the Summer Learning Lab and stay as long as they like, while enjoying free wifi, and comfortable seating in the media center. On-site support will be available from Farmington Public Schools' teachers.

All classes will be self-paced and can be completed virtually through the Edgenuity system. Students can take up to two **repeat credit** classes to earn credit toward graduation. Students may take one **new credit** class to open up room in their schedules to take additional elective classes.

All virtual classes include **live support and extra help from a highly qualified Farmington Public Schools' teacher**. On-demand live chat/live whiteboard support is also available and included any time through the Edgenuity system. Classes are self-paced, and students may complete their work at any time within the four-week program.

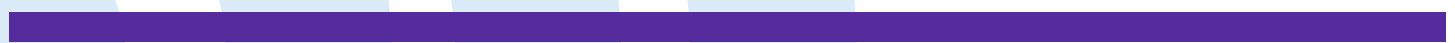


NEW! FREE “Booster” courses

Booster Courses help ensure students learn the most essential content and skills to prepare them for success in the next grade level. Each lesson begins with a pretest to assess the student’s proficiency of the skills covered in that lesson, enabling them to focus on improving skills they have yet to master. Booster courses are a great way to help set your student up for success in the next grade level!

Important Policies:

- World Language courses are not available during summer classes.
- NEW Credit: Students earn credit/no credit; courses do NOT impact GPA.
- Repeat Credit: Students earning an A or B receive a letter grade. Students receiving a C or lower receive credit/no credit.
- Courses MUST be completed by August 1 to earn credit.
- Course Final Exams must be supervised by a Farmington teacher, by appointment virtually, or by walk-in to the Learning Lab.
- Students must have a compatible personal device and Internet access to enroll in courses. Farmington Public Schools' students may continue to use their FPS-issued Chromebooks for summer school courses.
- Honors Classes: Honors classes are not offered in FPS summer school. If a student wishes to retake an honors class in FPS summer school, they are encouraged to register for a "non-honors" version of that summer course. However, both grades, the original honors grade, AND the summer school repeat credit grade, will be listed on the student's transcript, and included in the student's GPA. For students who received a B, C, or D, building principal approval is required to enroll in the non-honors version of the summer course. For students with a failing grade, no special approval is required. Students wishing to replace their honors grade for GPA purposes must retake the course in FPS during the regular school year, or find an equivalent honors course outside of the district that must be reviewed/approved by the building principal.
