### FPS District-Wide Scholarships

\_\_\_\_\_ Farmington Education Association Scholarship (sponsored by the FEA supported by the Farmington / Farmington Hills Education Foundation) **Amount up to \$1,000**. Award based on scholarship, financial need, community service, leadership, attendance at Farmington Public Schools for at least 3 years, GPA above 3.0, strong SAT/ACT scores. **Applicants with connections to education (intending a career in education, parent who is an educator, etc.) are strongly encouraged to apply. Recipient must attend an in-state college or university.** Only the common application is required to apply for this scholarship.

\_\_\_\_\_ Farmington Area Senior Scholarship (sponsored by David Clark, DDS & Carolyn Romzick, DDS) **Amount \$1,000**. Award based on attendance at a four year college, majoring in math or science, GPA of 3.5 or better, outstanding character and participation in extracurricular activities. In addition, include one of your college admission essays with a cover page on why you are best suited to receive this scholarship. (No name or school should appear in the essay. The essay should be double-spaced in 12 point font, 2 pages or less.) There will be up to three award recipients for the district. \_\_\_\_\_ Farmington Hills Police Officer Association and Grand Tavern Scholarship (sponsored by FHPOA and Grand Tavern supported by the Farmington / Farmington Hills Education Foundation) **Amount \$1,000**. Seniors from Farmington, Harrison or North Farmington High Schools that will attend community college or college/university in Fall 2018. There will be three award recipients for the district. This scholarship has two applications, the common application and a separate scholarship-specific application.

\_\_\_\_\_ Hackbots 3414 (sponsored by Hackbots 3414 supported by the Farmington/Farmington Hills Education Foundation) **Amount \$1,000**. This special scholarship will be awarded to a graduating member of the 3414 Hackbots robotics program that has been accepted to an accredited Michigan community college or college/university and is actively involved in Hackbots 3414. This scholarship has two applications, the common application and a separate scholarship-specific application.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Susan H. Zurvalec Leadership in Diversity Scholarship** (Sponsored by the Farmington/Farmington Hills Education Foundation) **Amount \$1,000.** Award based on involvement in diversity activities, leadership and essay on the importance of diversity and positive race relations. Detailed guidelines on this merit-based scholarship are available online and in the Counseling Office. This scholarship has two applications, the common application and a separate scholarship-specific application.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Beechview Alumni PTA Scholarship** (Sponsored by the Beechview PTA) **Amount two \$500 awards** Student must have attended Beechview Elementary School for at least two years; must currently be enrolled in a Farmington Public School; and must have "accepted" status at an accredited institution of higher learning. NOTE: There is no common application required for this scholarship application. As directed send your completed Beechview Scholarship application and the required attachments to the address listed on the form by 03/27/2018.

\_\_\_\_\_ **C. Robert Maxfield PTA Council Scholarship** (Sponsored by Farmington PTA Council) **Amount three \$500 awards.** Student must have been active in a high school PTSA for at least one year, currently be enrolled in a Farmington Public School, must have "accepted" status at an accredited institution of higher learning. This scholarship has two applications, the common application and a separate scholarship-specific application.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Gill PTA McKennett Memorial Scholarship** (Sponsored by the Gill PTA) **Amount \$500 award.** Attended Gill Elementary, interested in music, religion, art, sports and putting those interests into action through community service/volunteer work; member of a high school PTSA; and not related to a member of the Gill PTA Scholarship Committee. NOTE: There is no common application required for this scholarship application. As directed send your completed Megan & Michael McKennett Memorial Scholarship application and the required attachments to the address listed on the form by 3/27/18.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Kenbrook Elementary PTA Scholarship** (Sponsored by the Kenbrook PTA) **Amount two \$500 awards.** Student must have attended Kenbrook Elementary for at least one year, currently be enrolled in a Farmington Public School, must have "accepted" status at an accredited institution of higher learning. This scholarship has two applications, the common application and a separate scholarship-specific application. NOTE: There is no common application required for this scholarship application. As directed send your completed Kenbrook Scholarship application and the required attachments to the address listed on the form by 3/27/18.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Kay Briggs Memorial Scholarship** (Sponsored by the Farmington/Farmington Hills Education Foundation) **Amount \$1,000 renewable award.** Plans to major in Education or Engineering; US Citizen; Farmington area resident for more than two years, and demonstrates school and community involvement and leadership. **Amount \$500 award.** Must have taken a choir and/or acting class; maintained a B average in all choir/acting/English classes; accepted to an accredited institution of higher education; and participated in a play or musical at FHS in any capacity. This scholarship has two applications, the common application and a separate scholarship-specific application.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Fred Nassar Memorial Scholarship** (Sponsored by the Farmington High School PTSA)

**Amount \$500 award.** Scholarship awarded to a student involved in FHS teams or organizations who exemplifies Mr. Nassar's dedication to school and community services. This scholarship is offered in memory of Fred Nassar, an avid volunteer and PTA leader in Farmington Public Schools. Mr. Nassar made a difference through school and community service.

**Amount \$100 award.** 3.0 GPA, some financial need, participation in sports at Harrison. This scholarship has two applications, the common application and a separate scholarship-specific application.
