Presented to a graduating senior who meets the following criteria:

- Will be attending Michigan State University (MSU) in the fall of the current year.
- Has a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5 (through first semester of his/her senior year).
- Has participated in community service.
- Has participated in extracurricular school activities.
- Has financial need.

The candidate shall complete the scholarship application, an essay entitled: "What This Scholarship Would Mean to Me" and obtain two recommendations from North Farmington High School (NFHS) teachers and/or counselors.

The Norman family will recommend the award recipient in conjunction with the NFHS selection committee, comprised of the NFHS principal, an NFHS teacher who is a graduate of MSU, and others as recommended by the NFHS principal. Representatives of MSU will confirm final selection. If no worthy candidate exists, the award will not be presented for that year.

The award will be a monetary sum of \$10,000, payable directly to MSU, in the amount of \$2,500 per year over a four-year period, provided the recipient remains in good standing.



Kara graduated from North Farmington High School in 1994 and received her Bachelor of Arts Degree from the Eli Broad College of Business at MSU in 1998. Kara was a caring, fun-loving, genuine person who made friends easily and had a tremendous zest for life. She was motivated and exhibited a positive attitude in all of her endeavors. The ideal candidate will exemplify these qualities that made Kara so special.

The Kara R. Norman Memorial College Scholarship will be presented each year at Senior Awards Night. A member of the Norman Family or their designee will present it.

The recipient shall express acknowledgment of the award in writing to the Norman family within three weeks of notification of the award.

In addition to the monetary award, the recipient will be given a commemorative plaque and will have his/her name engraved on a permanent plaque to be displayed at NFHS.
