ALERT! A NEW Sport Specific Transfer Rule is in effect. ANY sport a student plays now in 2018-19 determines eligibility in 2019-20 should the student transfer and not meet one of the 15 stated Exceptions.

Athletic Eligibility

Many factors are used to determine athletic eligibility. Current and previous academic record (must be passing 4 out of 6 classes), credit load, enrollment, age and transfer status are just a few of the factors.

Students who enroll at Harrison, North Farmington or Farmington are able to participate in that school's athletic programs, providing they meet all eligibility requirements. It is essential you understand the rules regarding eligibility of students transferring from one high school to another. Please keep in mind, all other eligibility factors must also be met.

Farmington Public Schools is not an open-enrollment district. In order to enroll in school, the student must be a resident of the attendance area for the specific school the student will attend.

Enrolling in or transferring from another school:

- When a student enrolls at a high school as a first-time freshman, the student is immediately eligible for athletics provided they have not been enrolled or attended another high school.
- If the student has attended another high school and transfers to one of our high schools, that student will not be immediately eligible.
- Students who are granted an Administrative Transfer from one high school to another within Farmington Public Schools will not be immediately eligible.

According to the MHSAA and taken from the MHSAA Handbook 2015 - 2016:

SECTION 9 (A)—A student enrolled in grades 9 through 12 who transfers from one high school to another high school is not immediately eligible to participate in an interscholastic athletic contest or scrimmage in the school to which the student transfers, UNLESS the student qualifies under one or more of the Exceptions (as listed in the MHSAA handbook) and all related Interpretations.

- 1. A student who does not qualify for one of the exceptions under Section 9(A) and has transferred (changed enrollment) by the fourth Friday after Labor Day, becomes eligible for interscholastic scrimmages and contests the following Martin Luther King Day (Monday) regardless if classes are actually conducted on that day.
- 2. Except for the conditions of Sections 9E or 9F, a student who does not qualify for one of the exceptions under Section 9(A) and has transferred (changed enrollment) by the **fourth Friday of February**, becomes eligible for interscholastic scrimmages and contests the following August 1st

Please be aware, transfers that are determined to be athletically motivated may render the athlete ineligible for 180 school days (a full year).
