- 4. AP Scholar with a score of 5 on 4 different AP exams OR IB Diploma student with a 6 or 7 on 3 HL IB exams OR any student who takes any combination of 3 IB or AP courses and receives a 6 or 7 on the IB tests, and a 5 on the AP tests.

Disqualification

A student would be disqualified from the Academic Hall of Fame if they had been found guilty of academic fraud or cheating.
